By aggregating data from healthcare settings across a community, CALiPR enables clinical quality measures (CQMs) to be more complete and accurate, therefore reducing the reporting burdens faced by providers today under federal and state incentive or value-based payment programs.

- + Electronically Submit Results for MU & QPP**  
Eligible providers and staff can report their eCQM results electronically to state and federal for incentive and value-based payment programs.
- + Efficiently Use Healthcare Resources**  
CALiPR eCQM results aim to inform providers and program staff when a care gap exists with a patient, so they may act on the opportunity to provide focused patient care.
- + Drive Quality Improvement Initiatives**
